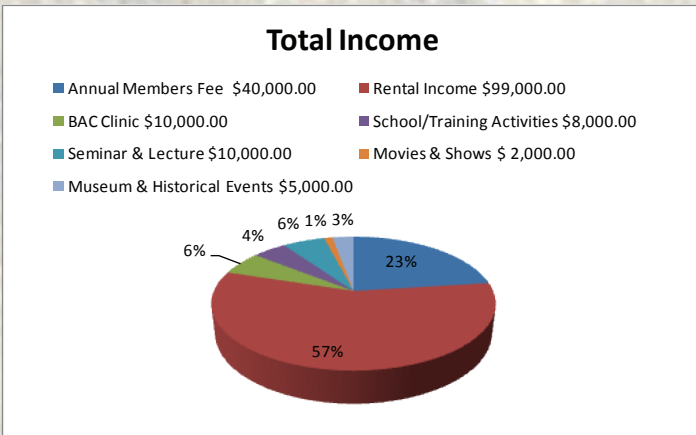


Our outreach programs include weekend school for children, food drive for the hungry, community blood drive, financial or moral support, and a free medical clinic, which is open to the public. We are here to help when one needs help, but we do it

together as a community by generating support from many. We encourage and support our community members to come together to give back to the community they love and cherish!



BAC is focused on community development, promoting multi-cultures and diversification, and pursuing and achieving common goals in preserving the American and Bangladeshi culture and heritage. With these goals in mind the community got together and bought 4 acres of land in 2001. There is a small mobile home on the property, but we dream BIG to have a fully functional community center on this land, with your help.



Our Project Development Plan:

To develop 4 acres BAC master plan would cost the community approximately \$2.5 million in present value over the next 5-7 years. This master plan consists of a 13,000 Sq. ft. two-story auditorium facility, sports complex, a walk trail and a Shohid Minar to symbolize the International Mother Language Day. This project will be developed in several phases and initial target is to complete the auditorium facility at an estimated cost of \$1.5 million, by the end of 2014.

Our Projection 2012-2014:

To achieve our initial goal of \$1.5 million by 2014, we have to rely heavily on the main-stream community support. The need for donation from everyone in the community is vital to the success in completing the project. No donations are small as we need over 200 families to pay \$250.00 annual donation as donor-membership, along whatever the general population can pay from \$50 per person to as low as \$20.00 per month donations..

BAC Sustainability:

To sustain the ongoing maintenance of BAC facility after construction, the community needs to endow in the near future. Rental income generated from the utilization of the facility can help alleviate to ongoing maintenance cost; however, this rental income alone will not be sufficient to sustain this 13,000 square foot complex. We project that we will have additional income to offset the maintenance of the facility once the Phase 1 is completed.

Objectives:

One of the BAC objectives is to have a common ground for the Bangladesh-American Community to facilitate activities to celebrate and showcase Bangladesh's rich cultural heritage. This Community is represented by professionals, students, men, women and the children along with many of Bangladeshi-American organizations or groups. BAC is the venue and physical address of "Little Bangladesh" in Houston, Texas, which will not only focus on the multi-cultural activities, but also be a place for community service for peace and harmony with enriched outreach programs.
